4	Stainless steel/aluminum cooking pot with handles and lid, 5 l.	1

NOTE 1: Households with 6 or less members will receive 1 NFI kit. Households with 7 and more people will receive 2 NFI kits. When possible to conduct a more detailed assessment, households with 7 and more will receive the items according to their number of members.

NOTE 2: Mattresses will be distributed to very vulnerable population identified during the post distribution monitoring.
